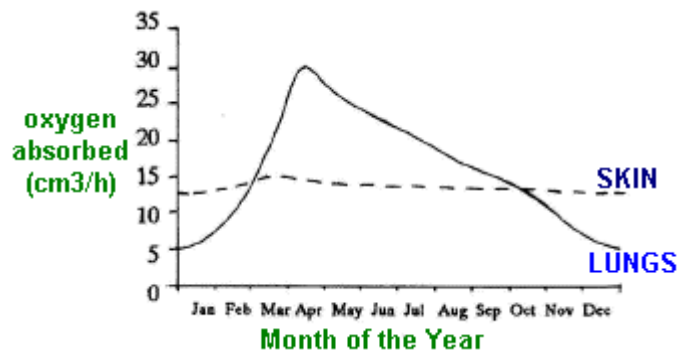


Animals which Breathe through their Skin
